## Academic Support

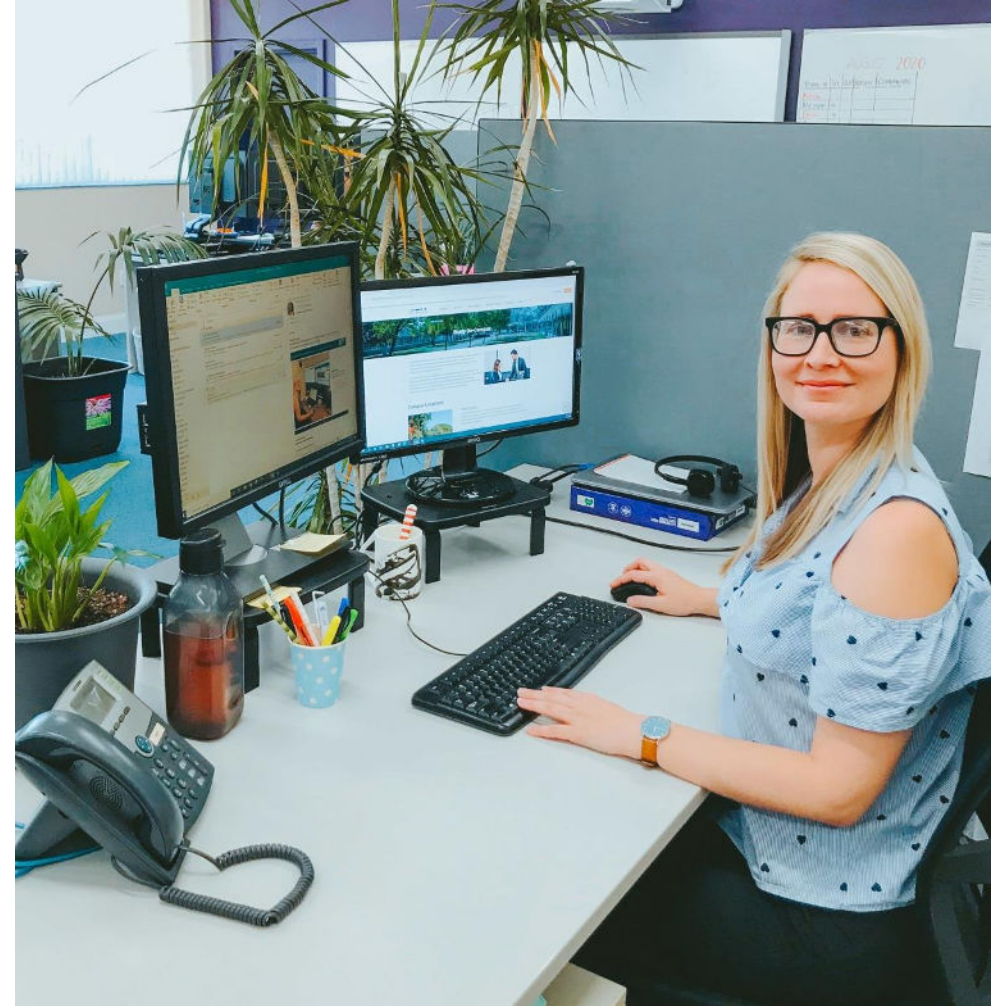
The academic faculty ensures that you receive a high quality education. They will look after your; learning experience, practicals (workshops, remote and virtual labs) and the work integrated learning component.
